



Research Study About Communication Between Children Who Are Hard-of-Hearing and Their Parents



Help us learn more about how parents talk with their children during mealtimes and while playing board games!

Who: One parent and their child aged 6-9 years who is hard-of-hearing in both ears and wears at least one hearing aid. Children with additional disabilities other than hearing loss who are able to communicate via speaking and are able to play board games are welcome!

What: Conversations with your child while eating a meal and playing board games, as well as a standard language assessment for your child and web-based parent surveys.

How: After learning and practicing the board games together with your child (about 2 hours on your own time) and filling out surveys online (about 2 hours by yourself), you and your child will participate in three separate, 20-40 minute Zoom calls on a personal computer with a researcher. The board games will be yours to keep and enjoy!
